KNOWLEDGEABLE: Many large companies boast of having an entomologist on staff, but how often is an entomologist needed and what good is he if he works in a corporate office located miles away? The vast majority of insects that cause a problem are easily identified by our staff, but if an unusual insect is found, it can quickly be identified by the extension Service at Iowa State University. More important is the value gained from our staff Chemist. How will a pesticide react in the environment? How long will it last. Will a pesticide be effective in your particular setting? What health risks are there from using a pesticide? These are all questions better answered from someone who has studied and understands chemicals than from someone who has studied insects.

QUALIFIED: Training is an important factor for insuring quality service. As required by law, all of our service technicians are certified by the State of Iowa, receive six hours of continuing education each year, and many are also certified in Illinois. However, training does not stop here. Bosch Pest Control, Inc. has accumulated an extensive pest control library (videos, slides, and books), holds regular in-house training sessions and annually attends several well-known and respected training seminars—e.g., Purdue Pest Control Conference, Kentucky Fumigation Workshop, Fumigants and Pheromones Seminar, Okumura Pest Identification Workshop, etc

PROFESSIONAL: Bosch Pest Control, Inc. is a long standing member of both the Nation and Iowa Pest Control Associations. Michael Rudolph has served as its Director in charge of Public Relation.

SAFETY: Bosch Pest Control, Inc. has never been cited by either the Iowa Department of Agriculture, or the Illinois Department of Public Health. Each of our trucks is equipped with the necessary safety equipment and our personnel required to attend regular safety meetings.
